Thank You!

My precious sheep:

The New Year has begun! 2018 is in full swing! How are you doing with those New Year resolutions? They might be going strong; they might not be. In contemporary culture, the third Monday of January (Jan 15 this year) is called "Blue Monday" because it's considered by some the most depressing day of the year because by then many people have given up on their new year's resolutions. I don't know if that's the case with you or not. But as a Christian you need not feel "blue" or depressed because regardless of whether you have fulfilled those resolutions or not God still loves you just the way you are and He will always love you.

This leads me to our current sermon series. Currently, I am preaching through the book of Galatians and my sermon series is entitled "Got freedom?" because freedom is the foremost theme of the book of Galatians (see Gal 5:1). Do YOU have freedom

in Christ? Are you free and secure and satisfied in your identity in Christ? The key to enjoying freedom in Christ is knowing who you are in Him and being fully satisfied and content and overjoyed and at peace in your Christian identity alone. Too often our identity is in other things like our career or how much money we make or our stuff or our appearance etc. But we all know that if our identity is in these other things (the Bible calls them idols) sooner or later they're going to let us down because none of us can enjoy all of these things for too long living on this sin-cursed planet. These things are ok, but just don't make them ultimate. Don't derive your identity and self-worth from them because sooner or later they will let you down. Idols always disappoint eventually. "Don't store up for yourselves treasures on earth...but in heaven" (Matt 6:19-20).

Another prominent word in the book of Galatians is "justification" and it's related to the concept of freedom. Let me explain. Justification is a word from the law-courts and it means "not guilty, innocent, acquitted of all charges." That means that as a Christian, because of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross for you, you have already been declared "not guilty" in God's court of law; your verdict has already been decided on the (future) Judgment Day. Hallelujah! Recently, I've also heard the word "justification" defined simply as "acceptance" (by Tim Keller). This means you have been accepted by God in Christ for the future (on Judgment Day) but it also has implications for your identity in the present. This is where freedom comes in. To know that you have full acceptance by God in Christ ought to bring a sense of freedom in this life and confidence in your identity. Why are we so concerned about our careers and our talents and the size of our bank accounts and our appearance? Is it not (in part) because society measures acceptance by these things and we want to look good before others, because we want the praise (and acceptance) of others? But all that acceptance you're looking for in the world and in our culture you have in Christ perfectly (and so much more – cf. Eph 2:7)! Don't live for the praise of man. There's no freedom in that – remember Paul says that in Galatians 1:10.

This is the gospel, my friends. The gospel provides a dual blessing: 1) It's the message that will take us to heaven when we die (or when the Lord returns – "Maranatha!") and 2) It's the message that will transform us on earth (by giving us a sense of freedom, and joy and peace and love in the Holy Spirit). The reason I am preaching through the book of Galatians is to help you understand this gospel and be transformed by it. And once we're transformed by it, we will want to see other people

transformed by it. This is where the fourth part of our vision comes in – INVITE (there's a method to my madness, you see!). Let me encourage you to invite your unchurched or unbelieving friends to our church. Find your one lost sheep (Luke 15:1-7). How are you doing in finding your one lost sheep? In one of our Sunday school classes we are learning practical tips for sharing our faith and finding our lost sheep. We are going through the book by Pastor Bill Hybels entitled "Just walk across the room." There are many good tips in this book. A foundational one which we are studying is learning to follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit when it comes to personal evangelism (as Pastor Hybels says to develop "an ear fine-tuned to the promptings of the Holy Spirit" [pg. 35]). He encourages us to recite the following prayer every morning and I hope you will pray this prayer:


"My life is in *your* hands, God. Use me to point someone toward you today – I promise to cooperate in any way I can. If you want me to say a word for you today, I'll do that. If you want me to keep quiet but demonstrate love and servanthood, by your Spirit's power I will. I'm *fully* available to you today, so guide me by your Spirit." (Pg. 37)
