## My precious sheep:

In this month's issue of the Link, I want to look at one verse from the Bible. It's important. It shows us how hostile our sinful nature is. It shows us that the Christian walk is a battle. Let me begin by asking you: What sin or sins do you struggle with? What are the strongholds in your life? We could begin with what we call addictions: alcohol, drugs, food, pornography, gambling. But there are other sins (some that are hidden) that are just as enslaving: anger, resentment, gossip, a critical tongue, complaining, envy, greed, deceitfulness, lying. Have you been in bondage to one or more of these for years? Or perhaps some other sin not listed here? Are you battling such today? Or have you waived the white flag of surrender? Have you accepted the fact that you'll never change? There's a saying, "A leopard can't change its spots." My problem with this saying is that we're not leopards! We're children of God indwelt by the Holy Spirit! I want to encourage you to keep battling the strongholds of sin in your life, and I pray this article will give you renewed strength and hope that you can grow in holiness. The Scripture I want to look at is 1 Peter 2:11. It says: "Beloved, I urge you, as sojourners and exiles, to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul."

### CONT'D...

First, notice the Apostle Peter informs us we're at war. That's strong language! Do you know your enemy? To win a war one must know their enemy and have a strategy. What are your strongholds of sin in life? Great victories were won in history by generals who had great strategies, like Alexander the Great and Napoleon. What is your strategy? Second, Peter says it's the "passions of the flesh" which wage war against our soul. Passions are the strong desires we have to sin. The flesh is our sinful nature. Spiritually speaking, we are dead to our old sinful nature. Yet, somehow and in someway, the flesh still lingers. And it has passions. How can we win the battle against these according to this verse?

There are two things that stand out. Peter begins by calling us what? Beloved! As Christians, we are beloved by God. Know that you are loved by God. This is the foundation. We love God then because He loves us. Do you believe this? Do you REALLY believe this? It can change everything for you. Brennan Manning, a famous Christian author and speaker used to say this: "I am now utterly convinced that on Judgment Day the Lord Jesus will ask one question and only one question, Did you believe that I loved you?"

The other thing Peter states is that, as Christians, we are

The other thing Peter states is that, as Christians, we are "sojourners" and "exiles." This shows that this world is not our home. The word exile means, "one who lives in a place that is not their true home." Imagine living as a refugee.

That's the idea. Peter has mentioned this already two other times in 1 Peter (1:1 and 1:17). It was important to him. How important is it to you?



"The LORD is my light and my salvation – whom shall I fear?
The LORD is the stronghold of my life – of whom shall I be afraid?" Psalm 27:1

What is your retirement plan? Is it age 65 on earth? Or at death in heaven? Philippians 3:20 says, "But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ." As sojourners and exiles, we should show some detachment from the world. We don't watch all the same movies that the world does or listen to the same music. We don't have the same goals and desires. How are you living different than your unbelieving neighbors? Would anyone notice the difference? The Christian saying is true that we are in the world but not of the world.

I am writing this on Memorial Day weekend. This is where we remember and honor those who have died in American wars so that we can live with freedom and peace. This is external freedom and peace. To live with internal freedom and peace will take us winning the war against the passions of our flesh. This will take sacrifice. It will take dying to ourselves. The world is out for our soul. Let them not have it! It's too valuable. I want to leave you with these words from Jesus, "What does it profit for someone to gain the whole world, but lose their own soul?" (Mark 8:36) Grace and Peace, Pastor James
