

PASTOR'S NOTES

PASTOR JAMES W. CARLSON

It says in **1 Corinthians 1:12**, "What I mean is that each of you says, "I follow Paul," or "I follow Apollos," or "I follow Cephas," or "I follow Christ." In this issue of the Link, I want to talk about what it means to be a pastor in the church. How the congregation should view the pastor and what expectations one should have of a pastor. I am not being selfish by addressing this topic. It is for the good of the church and the spiritual health of individual Christians.

In the verse quoted above, the Corinthian Christians were obviously in the wrong. They were divided around their favorite leaders in the church. Some preferred Paul. Others liked Apollos (probably because he was an eloquent speaker – **Acts 18:24**). Still others gravitated toward the Apostle Peter (Cephas). These Corinthian Christians lost sight of Who they were truly following. This kind of thing still happens today – I think worse than in Corinth! On the same block in our city, there are three evangelical churches (ours, Nations for Christ, and Elevation). People could say, "I am of Pastor James," or "I am of Pastor Fernando," or "I am of Pastor Matt."

The danger is we may draw so close to a particular pastor it's almost like that pastor becomes a substitute for Christ. Or like Christ is mediated through the pastor. The flip side is if the pastor does wrong or is perceived to have done wrong, the church member may become quite damaged spiritually.

Often when people talk about churches, they will say, "That's Pastor so-and-so's church." The church does not belong to any pastor, or any church member for that matter. It is the LORD's church! The church is the Body OF CHRIST, with many members, and ONE Head, namely, the Lord Jesus Christ.

CONT'D...

How then should we view the pastor? First, as a servant leader. In **1 Peter 5** Peter the Apostle addresses shepherds. He tells us in **1 Peter 5:2-3**, "Shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock."

Second, a pastor is a teacher. A teacher of God's Word. In the list of qualifications for pastors in 1 Timothy 3, almost all the qualifications are character-based. But one stands out as far as the skill of the pastor. It says, "able to teach" (1 Tim 3:2). There's a popular understanding that a pastor is a storyteller, but that's not found in the Bible. The pastor is a teacher (James 3:1).

The pastor teaches God's Word to feed the flock. Jesus told Peter three times, "Feed My sheep" (**John 21**). The pastor teaches God's Word to EQUIP the saints for works of service and for maturity (**Eph 4:11-13**). Ultimately, I believe the pastor is a disciple-maker. Please view me this way at CCC.

I do weddings and funerals, but this is not my calling. A pastor is not professional clergy that offers services to the community. I am not a marriage counselor. I am not a hospital chaplain. I am called by God to make disciples in the local church.


Please don't misunderstand me: I want to be there for all of you in the seasons of life, the highs, and the lows, to visit you in the hospital, to have coffee and lunch, to be genuine friends. But most of all I want to help nurture YOUR relationship with Jesus Christ! I want to see you growing in Him, bearing fruit for Him, praying to Him, depending on Him. I want to help Jesus Christ become your EVERYTHING! So that, when you die, you will be confident and eager to go home to be with Him.

"The LORD is my light and my salvation – whom shall I fear?
The LORD is the stronghold of my life – of whom shall I be afraid?" Psalm 27:1

I want to close by going back to 1 Corinthians. Paul addresses this same problem again later. He writes in 1 Corinthians 3:4-7, "For when one says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos," are you not being merely human? What then is Apollos? What is Paul? SERVANTS through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. So neither he who plants nor he who waters IS ANYTHING, but ONLY God who gives the growth."

Paul says twice in this passage IT IS GOD who gives the growth. Pastors are expected to grow churches, as if they are CEO's or entrepreneurs or program leaders. But Scripture shows us that we plant and water, but God gives the growth. I'm the guy who plants and waters.
