

PASTOR'S NOTES

PASTOR JAMES W. CARLSON

Back in 2003 there was a theft at a church in Midtown Manhattan. The thieves stole a 200-pound plaster sculpture of Jesus! What was strange though was that they had not taken the cross He was nailed to. They only stole the statue of Jesus but left the cross behind. The janitor of the church was at a loss as to why they didn't take the whole crucifix. This is a metaphor for how many people think of Jesus today: They want Jesus but they don't want the cross. They want Jesus but they want to leave the cross behind.

Yet, the cross is essential to our Christian faith – not only as the heart of the gospel but as a way of life for all Christians. We are to live a cross-shaped life. This is taught by Jesus Christ Himself.

If someone asked you, what is THE one commandment to keep as a Christian, how would you answer? Some might say the Golden Rule ("So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them"

- Matt 7:12). Some might say the Double-Love commandment (Love God & love your neighbor - Matt 22:37-40). What does Jesus say?

It's called the cost of discipleship. It appears in Matthew, Mark, and Luke. **Luke 9:23** says, "Then He (Jesus) said to them all: "Whoever wants to be My disciple MUST deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me." Jesus says, "And whoever does not carry their cross and follow Me cannot be My disciple" (**Luke 14:27**).


There are three parts to this command: 1) Deny yourself; 2) Take up your cross; 3) Follow Me. The first is to deny yourself. This is the exact opposite of what the world teaches. The world says, "Be yourself." But if it is sin, as a Christian, we must deny it. Oppose it. Resist it. It means saying "no" to yourself and saying "yes" to Jesus.

To justify certain lifestyles the world today says, "I was born this way." Instead of denying, they embrace. But we Christians have been born AGAIN. We have a new nature. We are a new creation (2 Cor 5:17). We are indwelt and empowered by the Holy Spirit. We still struggle with sin. But we deny that sin. Even if the urges are strong, we keep denying them.

The second part is the next step, "Take up your cross." We deny our sin, then we crucify it. We kill it. Paul writes in **Romans 8:12-13**, "So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you PUT TO DEATH (crucify) the deeds of the body, you will live." The Spirit will help us take up our cross.

The third part is, "Follow Me." Follow Jesus. Not follow our heart. Not follow our own way (our own path). Follow Jesus. Follow His example. Let's make it our ambition that our life looks like His life. He prayed regularly. Let's pray regularly. He read and studied God's Word. Let's read and study God's Word. He loved His enemies. Let's love our enemies.

It's not enough to just sing songs of praise and worship to Jesus, but then our life doesn't look like His. Jesus said, "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' but don't do what I say?" (**Luke 6:46**). Follow Jesus wherever He leads you.



"The LORD is my light and my salvation – whom shall I fear?
The LORD is the stronghold of my life – of whom shall I be afraid?" Psalm 27:1

This cost of discipleship is central to the Christian life. And yet, it seems to me that the whole idea of self-denial and taking up our cross is foreign to many Christians. This is something we must do daily.

What sin or sins do you struggle with? Is it resentment? Is it gossip? It is cursing? Is it lust? Is it anger? Being quick-tempered. There was a man in my former church who was known for being quick-tempered. And many people got used to it and said, "That's how he's always been. That's just how he is." I replied, "That may be how he is, but it's not how he's supposed to be." Deny it.

Someone made the great sacrifice, they died for their country and their death was not in vain.


We shall not forget and their memory shall live on.
